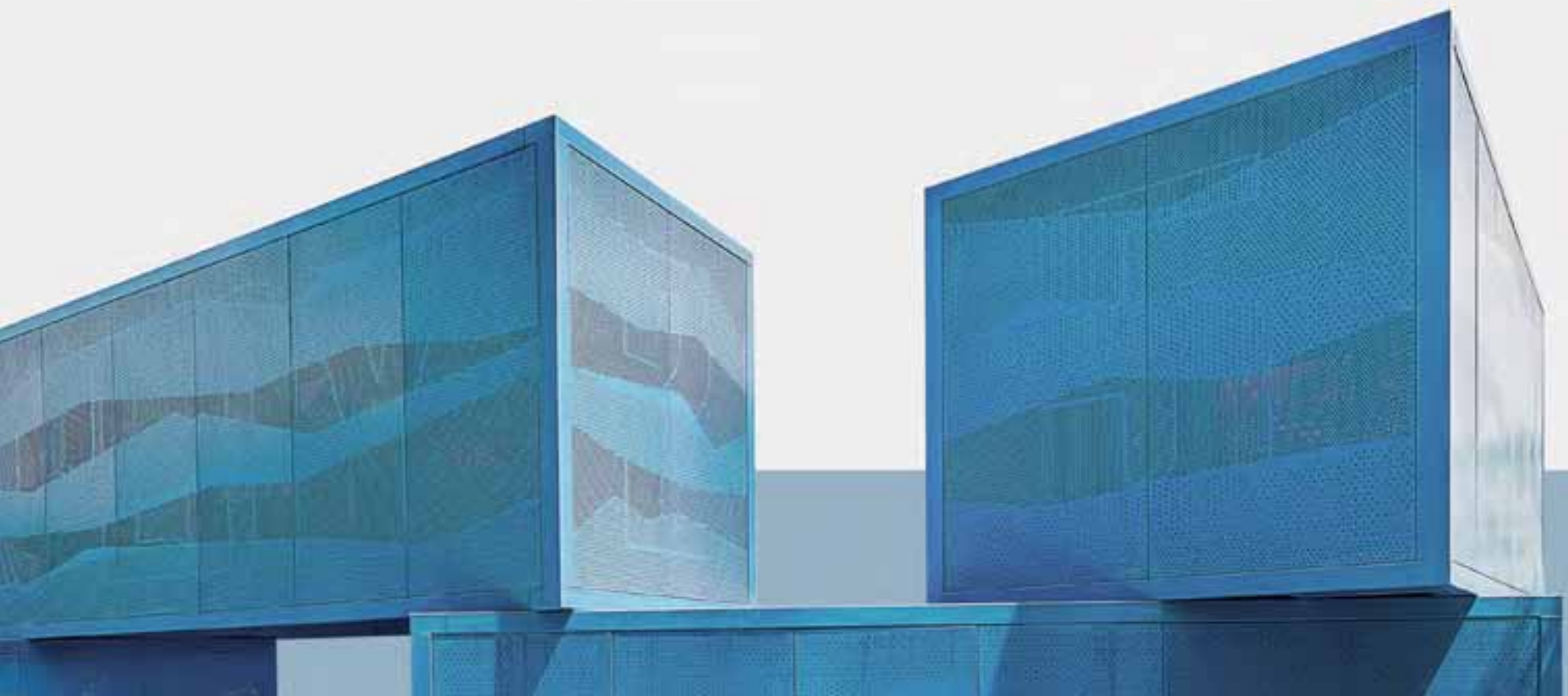

CAMPUS SEAT

The CAMPUS seat is made up of two sturdy 8mm thick powder-coated steel supports that are sandblasted and treated with a unique oxidisation cycle fine-tuned by Metalco, then shaped according to the design. The supports are supplied with upper and lower plates for ground fixing with anchors and to attach the slats with countersunk screws. The seat and backrest, where applicable, are made up of 150 x 55 x 2000mm autoclaved pine or exotic wood. All fixings are stainless steel.



SARAH BENCH

The monolithic SARAH bench is made entirely out of granite or marble stone mix, in various colours, the seats are dressed and sanded or bushhammered around the edges. The surface is protected by special satin opaque varnishes. Weight 620kg.



IROKO BIN

The IROKO litter bin is constructed from a strong steel tube structure with an in-ground fixing option surrounded by a 390mm, 525mm high cylinder made from 74x30mm section slats in autoclaved pine, mahogany coloured pine or exotic wood, fixed to a 30x4mm and 40x5mm steel plate frame. The 7mm thick steel ring is hinged to the structure and equipped with a sprint steel blade slam lock, for ease of removing rubbish from the 30 litre galvanised sheet steel liner.

Upon request, the filter bin can be supplied complete with cover and/or a circular steel ashtray provided with anti-theft cable. All metal parts are hot galvanised and polyester powder coated. All fixings are stainless steel.

The ALICANTE bench is made up of two feet of 121mm tubular steel, which narrows to 80mm in correspondence with the 7mm thick, 275mm circular base plate, linked to the frame and fixed with screws to the robust carrying bar in 140x60x2mm rectangular steel, all galvanized and polyester powder coated. 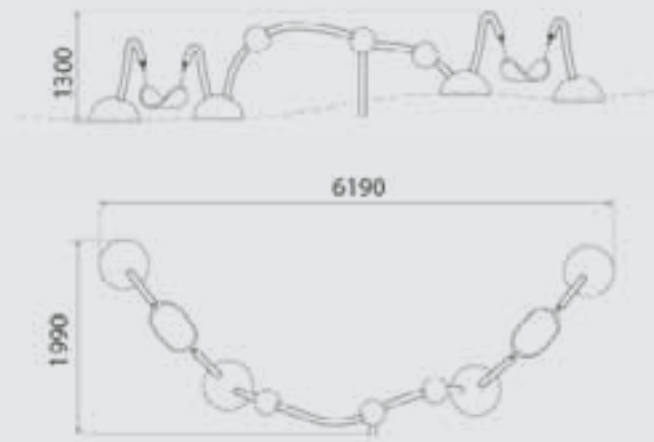
Comprises of Play boxes that stack on top of one another similar to the architectural design of the development. The Play Boxes are made of laser cut metal sheets to give a transparent look with custom-made patterns.



From a distance the perforated patterns display the words, “HIDE, SEEK” and numerical patterns with the numbers 1-8. This effect changes into a semi-transparent skin when viewed at close range.



The second playground, designed for kids of ages 2-5 years old and situated in the courtyard, comprises of play pearls and spinners.



The pearls form a unique abstract feature – consisting of spheres and tubular arches – which blend into the landscape. The unconventional form of this play structure attracts children to discover the hidden functions as it is not directly visible which function each pearl provides. This invites children to explore and discover.

The pearl play structure stimulates physical, cognitive, social, emotional, visual, tactile and creative development of small children.

The pearls are designed with at least 6 play functions. The pearls can be seen as modules, so every thinkable combination of pearls and links is possible.



They have a safe anti-slip coating, which is ideal for playing, sitting and climbing. An extra dimension of play is added by a sloping safety ground, creating a dynamic space. It is linked by arched tubes, which creates different horizontal routes to challenge children to find their own way from one pearl to another and discover various possibilities. It encourages children to climb, hang, swing, slide, run, jump, vault, turn and play hide and seek.

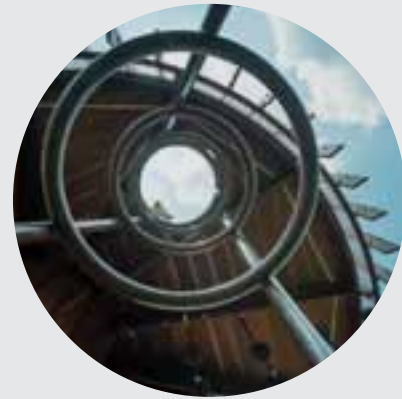

Playing on Kuma is like preparing for a space journey. At one end, there is a safe harbour, offering both shelter and climbing excitement. 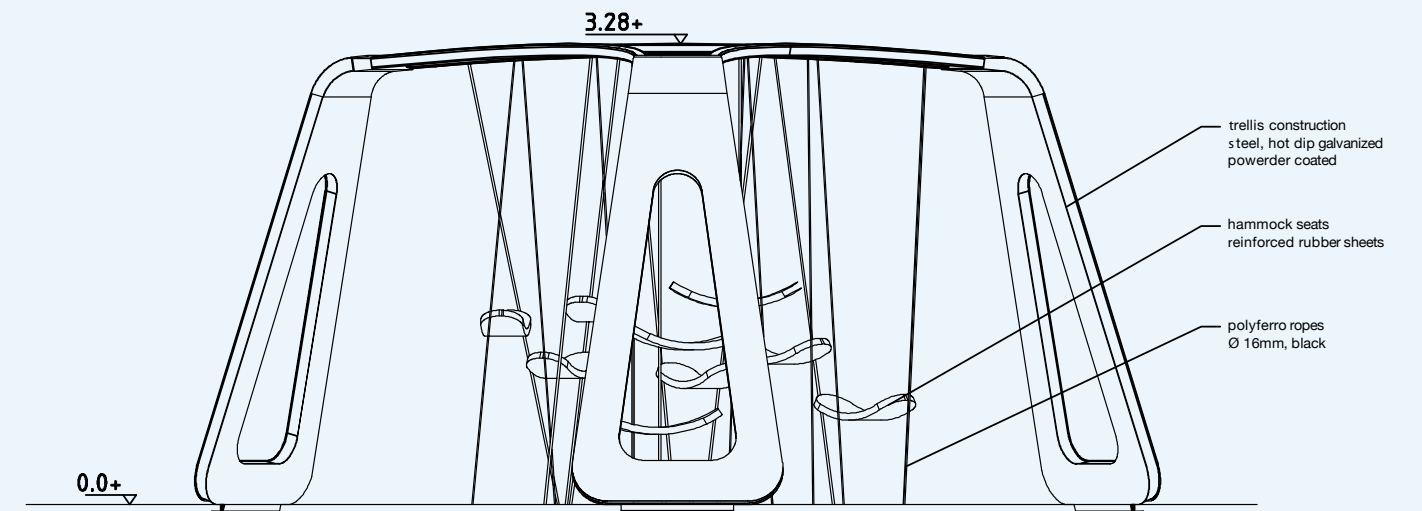

The Rope Net Bridge is a self-contained, cylindrical structure. The children can walk through the bridge or cross it hand over hand along the upper part. The curved net structure also makes a wonderful hammock as a place to take a break.

This bridge can either be used as an independent item of play equipment or as a means of ascent to a Spacenet or a free-standing slide.



BIG HARRIS BENCH

The BIG HARRIS COMPOSIZIONE bench is made up of three or four 7mm thick sheet steel supports with pre-drilled base plate for ground fixing with M8 bolts (not included). The Battle ship comes equipped with gun turrets, propellers, smoke stacks and even a rudder. The red climbing net beside the Battle ship is reminiscent of a naval flagstaff. 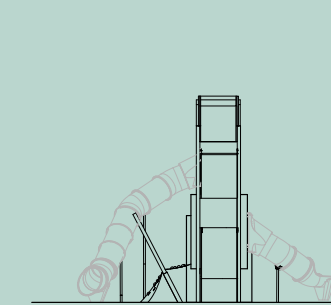
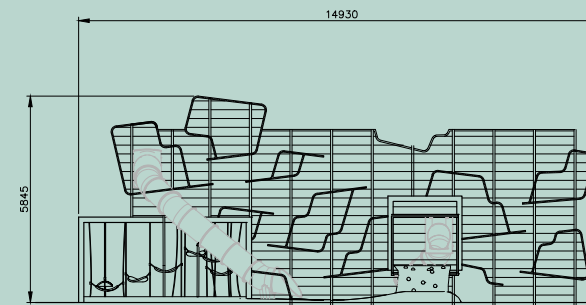
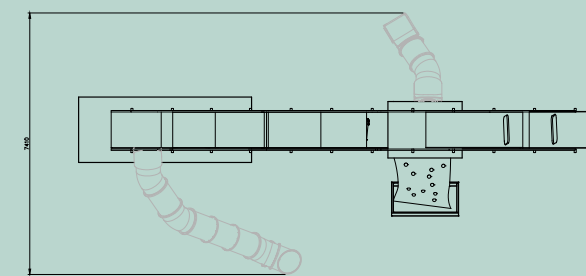




king crawler

The King Crawler comprises of multiple play elements with the king crawl vertical play as the main element. Users can challenge each other to climb up to the peak and they can return to ground level by sliding down the slide located at the end of the king crawler or simply just crawl back down.

Two slides of different heights are located at each end of the king crawler so as to cater to users of different age groups. Other play elements like the hammock and trampoline are created for users who wish to play on the ground level.

The SPYRA bike rack is spiral structure made from a 40mm diameter steel tube, which sits on the ground on turned steel cones, all sandblasted and zinc primer and polyester powder coated.

The seat is made up of four 6mm thick sheet steel supports linked to a robust horizontal 60mm steel tube and 16mm diameter steel tube profiles. Each profile is individually shaped depending on its position on the seat and closed off at each end with PVC caps. All fixings are stainless steel.

RIVOLA BENCH

WATERSHOOTER

The Watershooter T402P is an interactive Watertoy® which is activated by turning the handles. As the handles are turned towards a direction, the unit sends a stream of water from the nozzle. When the handles are released the water shuts off.



AQUADOME

The unit is specifically created for children of all ages especially suited for the toddlers. The children can crawl on this unit and play with the flush mounted nozzles. As jets from one or more nozzles are covered with hand or foot, the others grow in height. The jets are very gentle and not harmful to young ones.

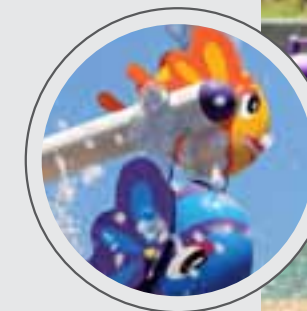
